## Personal Study & Small Group Questions

**2. Q:** How would explain the difference between Peace WITH God & the Peace OF God?

**3. Q:** Why is having peace seem to be NOT the normal experience of life? Read **John 14:27 & 16:33**. What stands out to you in these verses?

**4. Read Matthew 1:18&19**. **Q:** How do imagine Jospeh found out about Mary's pregnancy? How would YOU have responded? Share One experience in your life where you faced an unexpected challenge?

**5. Q**: What Can we learn from Jospeh's response? What do you think it means when it says that Jospeh was a "righteous" man?

**6.** Can you share an experience in your life where you did not or were not doing the right thing & your conscience (From God) or the Holy Spirit was not allowing you to have peace?

**7. Read Matthew 1:20; Philippians 4:4-7 Q:** How do you or can you practice the presence of God in your life to experience more of the peace with God and of God?

**11. Read Matthew 1:24 & Isaiah 54:10. Q:** What is one area of your life today others can pray for you for, where you are struggling with peace or obedience?
