

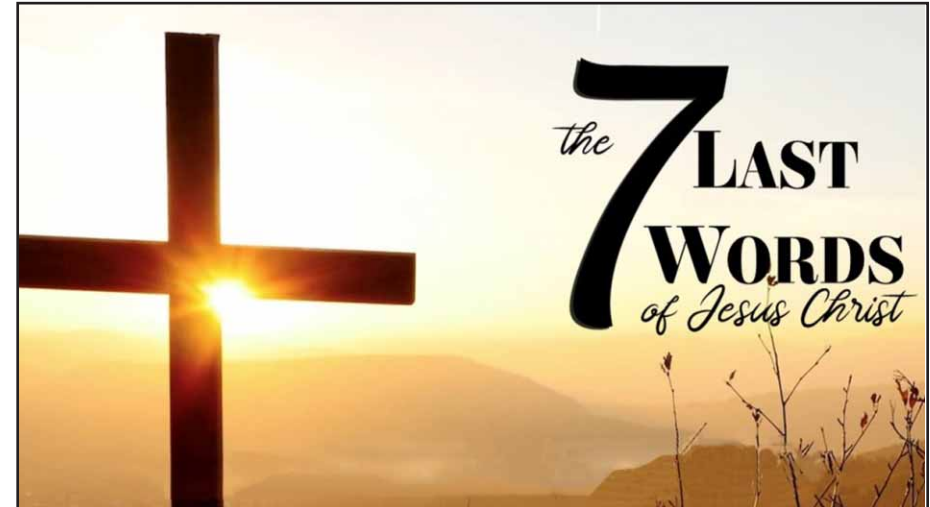
## Prayer Items - March 31st

1. Read John 19:23-30. This passage begins, "Later..." Describe what has happened up until this point.

Why did Jesus say, "It is finished"?

2. Read Luke 19:1-10. Jesus said, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham."  
Why was it such a big thing that Zacchaeus became a Christian?

Define what it is to be a, 'sinner.'

3. Read 1 Timothy 1:15 and 2 Corinthians 5:21. How did Jesus become, "sin for us"?

How do we become the, "Righteousness of God"? What does it mean to be the, "Righteousness of God"?

4. "It is finished" is a translation of the Greek word *Tetelestai*. This word is in the Perfect tense, which means past action that continues in the present. An example of this would be, "John has gone to the library," in other words, John went to the library and is still there now. Why is this significant to the word *tetelestai* with regards to us?

5. Pastor Peter gave four different ways that the word *tetelestai* could be used. The first was, "Paid in full." Read Romans 6:23 and 1 Cor 6:20. What was the price that Jesus paid for your sins? What should be our response?

6. The second was, "Sentence served." Read 1 Peter 2:24. What does it mean that Jesus, "bore our sins in His body"? What is the 'so that' in this verse, and what is necessary for this true in our lives? (Also read Isaiah 53:5)
