I – The P of Congregational Worship . Hebrews 10:19-22...

Matthew 18:20; Hebrews 4:16; Genesis 28:16-17; Psalms 122:1

*Worship is entering the p of God, the T Room of God

*We can enter the presence of God with B .. With freedom, without fear, with Joyful c ! But not arrogance!

*Worship is not just s , it's Worthship. Everything we do to express our love for God and His worth.

II - The N of Worship. Hebrews 10:22-25...

Congregational worship is vital for spiritual h and growth.

i) Congregational Worship Keeps us in a right relationship with G Hebrews 10:22

*Congregational worship is a place where we can **be r** with God and real with one another!

*Church should be a place of constant confession, re , and forgiveness

ii) Congregational Worship reaffirms our F and helps us stay faithful and true. Hebrews 10:23

iii) Congregational Worship keeps us in right relationship with other b . Hebrews 10:24-25.

*Matthew 24:12

*An indicator of our spiritual health, our relationship with God is our love and affection for other believers

7. Do you find church an easy or difficult place for confession, repentance , and forgiveness? Why or why not?

8. Read **Hebrews 10:23**. Do you ever struggle with what you believe or with your faith? How does this verse encourage you?

9. Read **Hebrews 10:24&25**. What does it mean to be concerned for others, what does this look like? How can congregational worship help us with this?

10. Read **Matthew 24:12**. Do you agree that our love for other believers is an indication of our Spiritual health and growth Why or why not?

11. How would you rate your current commitment to congregational worship? What might be an obstacle to you growing in this area? Is there someone you know that is missing out on this that you could try and encourage?
