Context: believers He has never met, from Corinth. Book of Romans is clearest and most systematic presentation of Gospel & Christian

Doctrine in Scripture! Written to a church that is experiencing relative peace and stability but will experience extreme persecution in a few years

Personal Study & Small Group Questions

- **1.** Read **Romans 7:14-24** Q: Can you relate to these verses? How? Do you think we have to live in this place as a Christian, why or why not?
- **2.** Read **Romans 8: 28-30**. Q: How do these verses reveal to us the purpose of the Christian life? Describe the different stages of our spiritual life mentioned and what each one means?
- **3**. Read **Romans 8:31-34** . Q; What do you think it means that God is FOR us? How can we be convinced that God Is for us and will never condemn us?
- **4.** Read **Psalm 118:6 & Philippians 1:6** Q: How do these verses help give you assurance of spiritual victory in your life?
- **5.** Q: Do you ever struggle with doubt or condemning thoughts in your Christian Life? How? How do you deal with them?
- **6.** Read **Romans 8:34 again** Q: What has Jesus done and currently doing to assure our spiritual victory? Why is each thing significant?
- **7.** Read **Romans 8: 35-36** Q: What kinds of Circumstances does Paul mention? What ones have you personally experienced? Q: What does Paul remind us of in Verse 36? Why is this important to keep know?
- 8. Read **Romans 8:37**. Q: How can we truly be victorious in ANY circumstance?
- 9. Read **Ephesians 3:17-19**. Why is knowing and experiencing God's love, the love of Jesus, so important? How have you experienced it in your life? How do you struggle with experiencing it?
- 10. Read **Romans 8:38-39.** What things in your life do you most fear or worry that will separate you from God or from Jesus? How can you become persuaded that nothing, even these things can and will not separate you from God?
