Small Group Questions (John 8:1-11)

Q1. Is anyone willing to share about a time when they felt they needed to make a choice between options that were only bad?

Q2. What do you do in these types of situations? Do you find it hard to seek God for these issues? Do you tend to rely on your own wisdom?

Q3. The Teachers of the Law (Scribes) and the Pharisees bring in a woman caught in the act of adultery. It seems that she was guilty. However, what makes this situation strange or suspicious?

Q4. The teachers and Pharisees are essentially asking Jesus if he will uphold the law that God gave to Moses. Instead of answering, he writes on the ground. Dan gave some ideas, but what do you think he was writing? (Try not to spend too much time on this question)

“Let any one of you who is without sin be first to throw a stone at her.”

Q5. What response does this question demand from its hearers?

Q6. Dan said Jesus wants all of us to take an inventory of our sin. How is that helpful when we feel judgemental towards others? (Rom 2:1-4)

Q7. Why do you think the oldest left first? (v9).

Condemned. Read John 3:18, Romans 3:23, 6:23.

Q8. What are your thoughts on Dan’s statement, “We are in desperate need of God’s grace, without the ability to save ourselves. If you don’t know that, you might be the proud person the Bible says God opposes.”

Compassion. Read Romans 5:18, John 3:16-17.

Consider: She was humiliated and found compassion because Christ was humiliated and found no compassion.

Commissioning. “Go and sin no more.” **Q9.** Why do you think it is important that Jesus included this instruction?
