1. Define doubt.

Are there some area's in your life where you have doubts?

- 2. What effect do doubts have on our lives? (e.g. Relationship with people, God, work, authorities like the police & government etc.)
- 3. Read John 20:19-23. The first thing that Jesus said was, 'Peace be with you, then He repeated it again later.

Pastor Peter said that the peace that Jesus gives is not the absence of struggles, or questions, but is rather the confidence to know that Jesus is there with you always. How does the peace of God dispel doubt?

- 4. Read John 20:24-29. The disciples had seen Jesus, but Thomas had not been with them. When we go through struggles, hardship, difficulties etc. we often alienate ourselves from the very people who could help us, which includes stopping going to Church. Why do you think this is?
- 5. Thomas wanted proof. He chose not to believe his friends. Pastor Peter Said that belief is a decision we make, enabled by the Holy Spirit. Read John 6:44 and John 12:32.

In what ways does God draw us to Himself?

 Verse 26 says, "A week later his disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them." This is very significant. God uses the assembling of ourselves together to minister to us and to those who are seeking. Read Hebrews 10:24-25.

Many people today say that they don't need to go to church to be a Christian, and they are right. Consider what the purpose of the 'church' is in the lives of Christians and the world. (Also read 1 Cor 12:12-32)

7. Pastor Peter talked about the importance 'Worship, Grow, Serve.' How do these three aspects of Christian life work together to make us faithful and fruitful in our walk with the Lord?
