1. Read 1 Kings 19:1-5a. It's hard to imagine a man like Elijah, who had just won a tremendous victory on Mount Carmel to be afraid of anything. Why do you think he was afraid of Jezebel and her threats?

2. Read 1 John 5:1-5. What is it that enables us to live as an overcomer?

Who is it that overcomes the world?

What does it mean to "overcome the world?"

- 3. Verse 5 says that an angel touched him, strengthened and encouraged him. Even thought Elijah was going in a direction that was against the will of God, He still came alongside Elijah. Read Romans 8:36-37. How have you seen this in your own life?
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 10:11-12. It is easy to think that we would not "fall." But when we look at some of the great men and women in the Bible, we see that they not ony struggled, but occasionally "fell." This would include Abraham, Moses, David, and Peter (among many others). Why is it that people who are so strong in their faith sometimes fall. What does this say about us? What do we need to do to make sure that we don't fall?
- 4. Read 1 Kings 19:5-10. Elijah was running. He was miserable, depressed, and wanting his life to end. God asked the question, "What are you doing here Elijah?" Why do you think God asked that question?
- 5. He took 40 days to make the 10 day journey to Mt. Horeb. When we find ourself wandering in the wilderness, like Elijah was, there is a battle going on for our mind. Read 2 Corinthians 10:5. How do we make our thoughts 'obedient to Christ?' (also read Philippians 4:8)
- 6. Read 1 Kings 19:10-18. Elijah had taken his eyes off God and onto himself and his problems. What did God tell Elijah to do? Why?
