
### oEmmanuel Prayer List - November 5th

### **Study Continued**

- 8. Read again 1 Kings 18:43-44. Pastor Peter said that we should Pray expectantly, pray persistently and pray believing. Elijah didn't allow the negative reports of his servant to stop him praying. His prayer in verses 36-37 was answered immediately, this time, however, he had to persist in prayer. What does this teach us about our prayers?
- 9. Read Luke 18:1-8. Why do you think this passage ends up with the question, "when the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on the earth?"
- 10. In verses 44-45. Elijah told Ahab to, "go, before the rain stops you," even though all he had seen was a small cloud rising in the distance. Elijah acted upon his prayers. When the sky started to grow dark, the Holy Spirit came upon Him, energised him, and he ran. We began this study with the statement that prayer is the key to living with expectation. What steps do you need to take in order to start, "living with expectation?"

- 1. Do you live life with expectation? Pastor Peter said that prayer was the key to living with expectation. Why?
- 2. Read 1 Kings 18:36-39. Elijah had been told by God that the 3 year drought was over, so go to King Ahab, and that He would send rain on the land (1 Kings 18:1). However, before the rain would come, there would be a confrontation on the top of Mount Carmel. From these verses, what was the purpose of this confrontation?
- 3. Read James 5:17-18. Pastor Peter said that prayer is the call of God into an interactive relationship with God. God is sovereign and has a plan and purpose to what He does. However, has chosen to use people as part of that plan. In what way is prayer used by God for His purposes?
- 4. Read 1 Kings 18:41-46. In verse 41, Elijah tells Ahab, "Go, eat and drink, for there is the sound of a heavy rain." When Elijah said this there wasn't even a cloud in the sky. So what was the sound that Elijah heard?
- 5. We need to make prayer part of our daily life. What are some of the ways we can 'pray' during the day?
- 6. In verse 42, when Elijah prayed, he bent down, humbling Himself before God. Read Matthew 6:9-13. The Lord's prayer is a pattern for prayer. It begins with acknowledging who God is. Why is this so important?
- 7. It is good to have a time and place to pray. Elijah went to the top of Mount Carmel, a place where he had just won a great victory over evil. Read Mark 1:35. Why did Jesus pick this time of day to pray? Why did Jesus need to pray?
