1. Read John 1:40-42 and Luke 4:38-39. This isn't the first time Simon has met Jesus. How have you seen God work in your life to bring you to God?

2. Read Luke 5:1-3. Simon has been listening while cleaning his nets, but now Jesus get's into his boat. Jesus knows Simon's circumstances, and wants to get his attention. In what ways does God get our attention?

3. Read Romans 10:17; John 12:32 and John 20:31. How do these verses explain how God draws us to Himself through His word?

4. Read Luke 5:4-10a. After Jesus had finished teaching the people, what was His instruction to Simon? Why?

What was Simon's response? Why?

5. When Simon saw what Jesus had done, he and those with him were astonished. How did he see Jesus following what had happened? (Compare Luke 5, verses 5 & 8)

How did he now see himself? (verse 8)
