

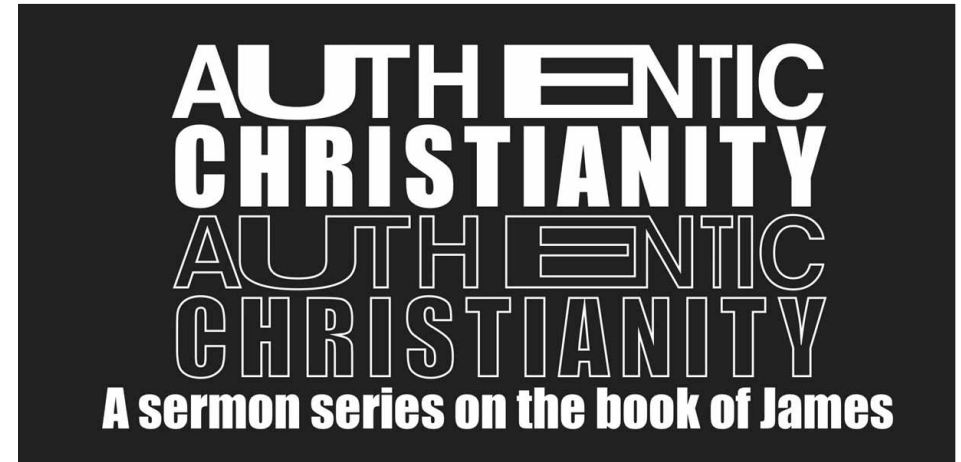
Emmanuel Prayer Needs

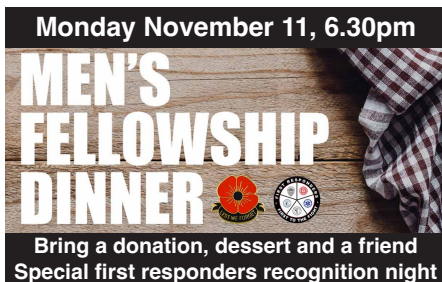
