For each group of people, what does Jesus say about each of them?


- Those who would not believe. (v.37-41)

1. Read John 12:12-17, Zechariah 9:9; Psalm 118:25-26 (Note: The word Hosanna comes from the Hebrew word: hoshia-na, meaning 'save now' and was an expression of praise and adoration)

Put yourself in the crowd that day. Try to imagine the excitement. You've heard about the raising of Lazarus from the dead - you even got to meet him and talk to him. Now Jesus starts to ride into Jerusalem on a donkey. You know the promise of a coming Messiah, what are your expectations?

What are your expectations of Jesus today? In the world? In your life?

2. Read Luke 19:37-44. The people desperately wanted peace, but were looking for it in the wrong places. They were expecting a conquering king, and deliverance from their enemies. However, the peace of God isn't the absence of conflict, it is the presence of Jesus. Read John 14:27 and John 16:33. What does the peace of God looks like in our lives?

3. Read John 12:20-26. What did Jesus mean when he said, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified?"

4. Jesus said: "Anyone who loves their life will lose it, while anyone who hates their life in this world will keep it for eternal life" (John 12:25). Based on what Jesus is teaching us here, how then should we live our lives in this world?

4. Jesus said, "Whoever serves me must follow me." What does that look like on a daily basis?

5. Read John 12:27-28. Why was Jesus' soul troubled?

6. Read John 12:32-33 and John 16:7-11. In what way did Jesus "draw all people to myself" when He was crucified? What is the work of the Holy Spirit in this?
