# **Gospel of John - The Samaritans Believe**

(John 4:27-42)

**2.** Rate yourself: on a scale of 1 to 10, how comfortable are you sharing the Gospel?

**3**. Dan said that the gospel was "feet-first". Read Romans 10:14-15 and talk about whether or not that is true.

**4.** What might it look like for you to "take" the gospel to people in your life? Should that be done with deeds, words, or both?

Acts 10 is an example of someone (Cornelius) seeking God, hearing from God, but still needing to hear the message of the Gospel spoken to them in order to receive it. You could read it, or not. Careful not to get too side-tracked though!

**5**. Have you ever missed getting the credit your deserved, or worse, seen someone else given the credit you deserve?

**6.** What does the desire to receive glory or recognition show us about our own hearts? Read Matthew 6:3-4.

Is it possible that we are looking for our own glory and not to simply give God the glory?

**7**. Dan said that the Gospel turns shame into glory. Is anyone willing to share about how this is true for them?

**8**. Read 2 Corinthians 12:9-10. Do find yourself boasting in your weaknesses? Or, are you still trying to hide your sin from the Lord, and from others? (worth saying: not every sin needs to be confessed to every person, however, it is amazing how God can use even the things we hate the most about ourselves and our actions)
