8. Read John 9:19-25. This blind man didn't care about the arguments as to who Jesus was, He just knew what He had done in his life. No one can take away from you what God has done for you. If everyone around you was behaving like these people, what would you say that Jesus had done for you? (Remember: He who has a testimony is never at the mercy of he who only has an argument - Charles Stanley)
9. Read John 9:26-34. The former blind man was astonished that these religious leaders couldn't acknowledge that Jesus was a man who had come from God. Why are people so reticent to say that Jesus is the Son of God?
10. Read John 9:35-41. The presence of Jesus brings judgement to us all by whether you accept or reject Him as being the Son of God. Jesus brought this man to a decision point in His life. What was his response?

Read Romans 12:1-2. What should be our response be to the mercy of God that has been shown to us?

1. How have you seen Jesus 'meet' you in the middle of suffering?

2. Read John 9:1-7. Try to put yourself in the position of this blind man. What was the attitude of the disciples towards this man? How do you think he was viewed in society? What about his parents?

3. Jesus said, "Neither this man nor his parents sinned," said Jesus, "but this happened so that the works of God might be displayed in him." What 'works of God' is Jesus referring to?

4. Read John 9:4-5. Jesus says, 'we', must do the works of Him who sent me. What does Jesus mean? (Also read Colossians 4:5-6 and 1 Peter 3:15)

5. The walk from the Temple (which is probably where Jesus met him), to the Pool of Siloam, is about 600M downhill, quite steep (vertical drop of 115M). It's about a 13 minute walk for most people, but for this blind man it would have taken considerably longer. What is going through his mind as he takes this 'walk of faith'?

Why do you think Jesus used the mud, and required him to go to the pool?

6. The question of suffering in the world is huge for many people, including Christians. If God is a God of love then why do bad things happen to good people? Why is there suffering? Why is there death? Why is there hell? Why do children suffer? How would you answer that kind of a question to someone who asked you?

Is there a question like that you struggle with?

Read 1 Peter 1:6-7 and Hebrews 5:8. What do suffering and trials teach us, and why is it so important?

7. Read John 9:8-18. Many didn't believe that he had been blind. Why is it that people struggle to believe it when God does a miracle in someone's life?
