Small Group Questions (John 11:1-44)

Q1. Can you remember a time when you were trying to make or build something only to have someone ruin it?

Q2. Five times, in Genesis 1, God declares His creation good. Then, at the end of the sixth day, He declares it to be, "very good." How is it possible that His creation has become corrupted? (hint: read Romans 5:12)

Q3. What is God's chief goal for your life? (hint: it is not to simply live a life free of suffering). Read 1 Thessalonians 4:3.

Q4. Dan said that often we want God to move in a situation immediately—to heal us, guide us, fix our problem. What are some reasons he may not act in the timeframe we find favourable?

Q5. Read Martha's statements in John 11:21-22. Psalm 13 includes a similar pattern of expressing emotion and even disappointment to the Lord while also expressing faith and trust in Him. Do you find that your prayers lean in one direction? Are you sometimes complaining without expressing faith, or, are you always expressing faith and never bringing your struggles to God?

Q6. John 11:35 simply states, "Jesus wept." What does this verse mean to you? What does it tell you about your saviour?

Q7. Jesus called Lazarus out physical death and into life. What are some ways Jesus has called you from life to death? (salvation is often a big one, what about other ways). Do you feel there is an area of your life Jesus is calling you out of currently?

Q8. Jesus got others involved in freeing Lazarus from his grave clothes. As part of the Church we are called to lean on each other. What are some reasons this can be difficult? (remember, just because it is difficult doesn't mean we can stop doing it)
