
Do you think of yourself as a, "new creation?" What is the significance of God saying that we are a, "new creation?"

1. Read Luke 19:1-10. Why do you think Zacchaeus was so desperate to see Jesus?

What do you think was the chatter among the people when Jesus went to Zacchaeus' house?

Why did Jesus say, “Today salvation has come to this house?”

Jesus came to seek and to save the lost. Who are the lost and what are they saved from?

2. In the parable of the lost son (also called the prodigal son, because he was so wasteful), what do you see of yourself, or people in general, in the younger son?

3. Verse 17 begins, “when he came to his senses...” What does this say about the nature of sin?

4. Read verses 18-20. When you do something that is hurtful towards someone else, do you think of it as a sin against God as well?

The son reckoned that because of his actions he wasn't worthy to be called a son of his father. What do you think of your “worth” to God and why?

How significant is it that the father was actually looking for the son, and saw him while he was still, ‘a long way off?’

5. This parable follows parables about a lost sheep and a lost coin. Each parable finishes with a celebration (see verses 7, 10 & 32). What does this say about how God values us?

6. Read Romans 6:23. What does it mean that the wages of sin is death? Why wages?

Why is eternal life called a gift?
