1. Read Colossians 1:15-16. Who is it who created all things and for whom were they created? How does this affect our view of why we are here on the earth?

2. Read Luke 9:57-58 (see also Matthew 8:19). This man is a religious leader, but Jesus is calling him to a whole new lifestyle, not just learn about God but to live a changed life. Do you think he followed Jesus? Why or why not?

Read Luke 9:23. What does it mean to deny yourself, to take up your cross daily, and to follow Jesus?
