


1. Read Revelation 2:12-13. How hard is it to live faithful lives with "no compromise?"

What are some of the attitudes, and actions, in the world in which you live that make it difficult to live a faithful, and godly, life?

- 2. Pergamum was a city where there was great persecution. It was the centre of Caesar worship, which was punishable by death for those who didn't participate. The pressure to conform was immense. Read Proverbs 29:25 What are some of the forces at work within us that make it difficult resist peer pressure?
- 3. Revelation 2:12 says, "These are the words of Him who has the sharp double-edged sword. What is the sword Jesus is talking about?

Read John 1:1-3; Eph 6:17; Rev 19:15; Heb 4:12. From these verses what are some of the many ways that the Word of God is active in the world?

- 4. Read Revelation 2:14-16. What is the reason that Jesus is so forceful about dealing with those who are compromising the faith?
- 5. The sin or these people is described by early church leaders as those who live lives of unrestrained indulgence. The world in which we live today isn't much different. It is especially sad when this kind of lifestyle infiltrates the Church. Jesus says that if those in the church do not repent then He will, "fight against them with the sword of my mouth." What does that mean, and what will be the effect?
- 6. Read again verse 13. The verse begins with, "I know where you live." If we are going to live faithful lives with no compromise, we must "know" the one who knows us, and what we are going through. What does it mean to "know" God?
