Nathan Wright - Be praying for Nathan, our new Youth Pastor, as he finds a place to live in the County, and prepares to come in late August.




3. Read Verses 1&2. **Q:** Why do you think God planned Jesus death to happen during Passover? **Q:** What does it mean that Jesus loved his "own"? **Q:** What does it mean that He loved them to the End? **Q:** How have you experienced God's love in your life? **Q:** How do struggle with God's love in your life?

4. Read Romans 8:31-39. **Q:** What are the things in your life that you allow or that seem to try and "separate" you from God's love in Jesus?

5. Read Verses 3-5. **Q:** What did Jesus "know" about Himself, and why do think it was significant? **Q:** What was so amazing about Jesus washing the Disciples feet?

Read Verses 6-8. **Q:** Why did Peter respond the way he did? **Q:** Imagine being a disciple in that room at the moment, what of you have thought? Felt? How would have responded?

9. Read Verse 12-17. **Q:** What is Jesus command to us? **Q:** What does serving one another like Jesus look like, practically? **Q:** What makes it difficult? **Q:** What is Jesus promise to us if we do? (What does it mean to be blessed?). **Q:** Do you have a "Peter" in your life? A Judas?
